I am writing this about 1 am Tuesday after I returned from my nephew's ninth birthday in Mississippi. He had a wonderful birthday and got his wish for 7 inches of snow. He made snow angels and two snowmen last week. I am very grateful to Father Rojas and Cross Catholic for being here last weekend and for all the work they do.

The second reading last Sunday was from the First Letter to the Corinthians. In the part we heard, Saint Paul told the community in Corinth that people had many different gifts in their community, and that this was not a flaw in God's plan, but rather a source of strength. A body that is made entirely of eyes, or hands, or any other body part is useless. It is the fact that people have different natural or spiritual gifts that enables us to function both as a parish and the Universal Church.

Very few of us can be actual missionaries; but with our prayers and material support, we can help that essential work of the Church. Locally, as a parish, we can use any talent or ability that you have. We need you. We can find a way to use what you are good at, and what you like to do, to support the work of Saint Peter. Just let us know.

- **St. Vincent de Paul Reminder**—St., Peter's St. Vincent will be teaming up with Bramble, Loogootee, & Washington SVdP and RSVP in Washington to help those impacted by the hurricane in North Carolina. On February 12th, at the Community Center at East Side Park, starting at 10 am we will be putting together 2,000 chicken noodle soup kits for families in North Carolina.
