Today we celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent. Every year the Gospel for this Sunday has an account of the Transfiguration of Jesus. This account, where Jesus discusses his "Exodus" with Moses and Elijah links the Law and the Prophets of the Old Testament with the Paschal Mystery we celebrate every Sunday. In the same way this "Exodus" links every good thing we do in our lives with the Passover of the first Exodus and the new Passover of the Resurrection of Jesus.

As we go through Lent there are a number of events that our parish will be offering. On March 30<sup>th</sup> Deacon Keith Hart will be providing a Lenten presentation at 6:30 pm with a meal beforehand starting at 5:30. Fr. Alex Zenthoefer will also be joining us on April 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm with a meal at 5:30 pm. Every parish in our diocese will be having reconciliation on April 2<sup>nd</sup> from 6 to 8 pm; and in addition, there will be several priests here for reconciliation on April 9<sup>th</sup> from 6 pm to 7 pm.
