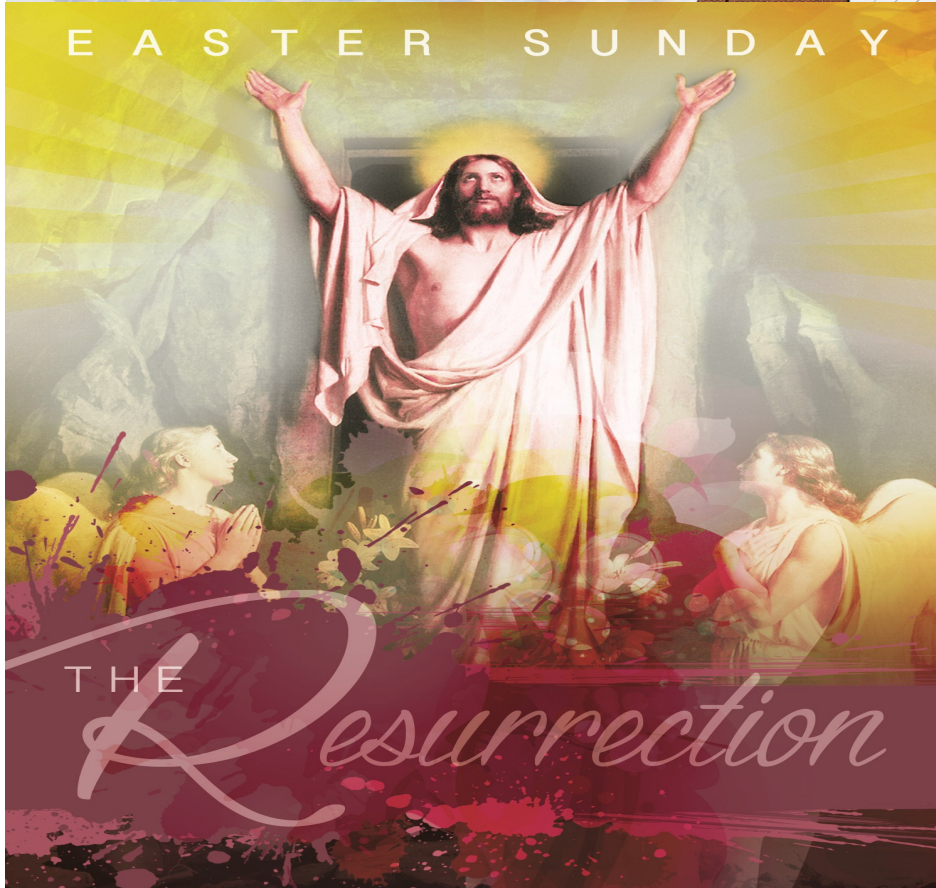

Happy Easter!

While we generally think of Easter as just Sunday, we believe that the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus is one single event. That is why the "three days" from Holy Thursday to Easter Sunday are their own liturgical season called the Triduum. Triduum literally means "three days." We know that we can't have Easter Sunday without Good Friday; and we can't have Good Friday without Easter Sunday.

With that said, Easter is the most important event of our liturgical year and as a result, like Christmas, we actually celebrate it for eight straight days, known as an "octave." Every day from Easter Sunday until next Sunday is actually Easter! We celebrate it again and again. If you come to a daily Mass this week; we say the Gloria, we say the Creed, we have the same Mass as on Easter Sunday ... because it is still Easter Sunday.

But it is now that our time of preparation during Lent bears fruit. The entire point of Lent is to get us ready for Easter; and the entire point of Easter is to get us ready for Pentecost where we are sent out to make disciples of all nations. This is where things get challenging for most of us, and this will be a focus for our parish over the next year.
