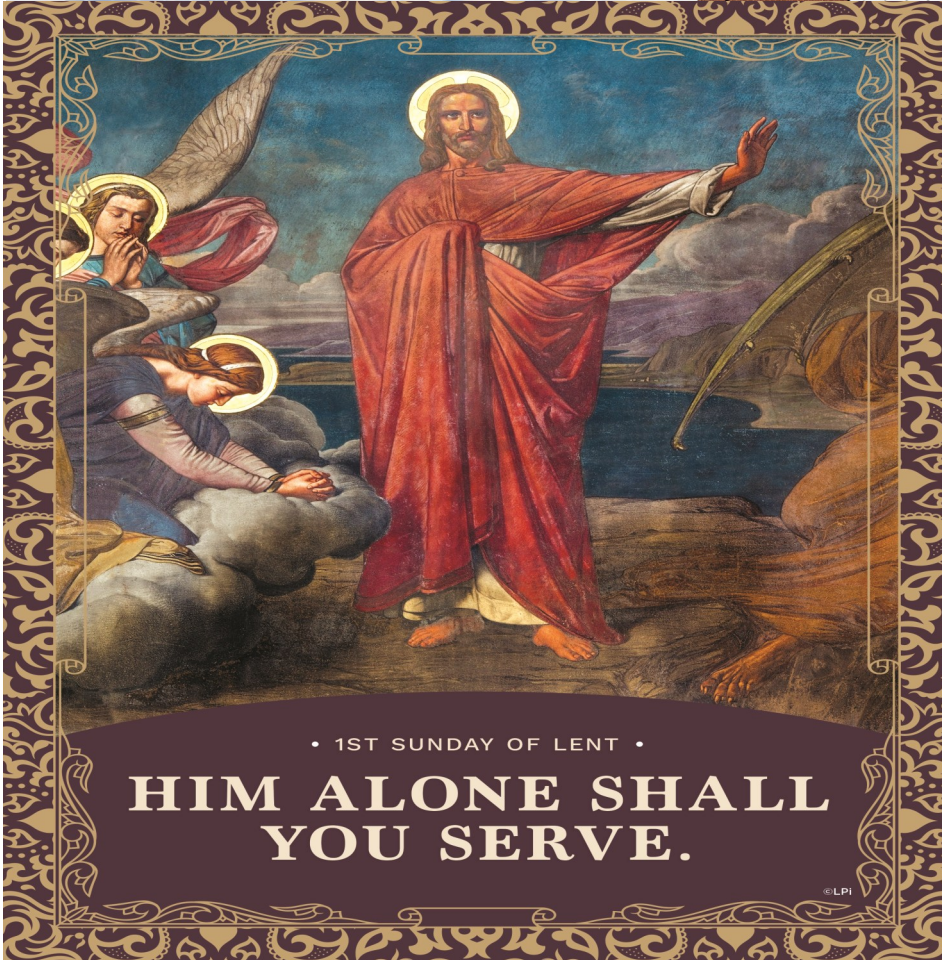

This weekend we celebrate the First Sunday of Lent.

One thing that is unique about Catholicism is that we often have two concepts that on the surface seem to be opposites but actually complement each other. On the one hand our bad choices, our failings, and our sins are always before us. On the other hand, we know that God desperately wants US and is always longing to bring us back into relationship with him. That is why Jesus created the Sacrament of Reconciliation, so that when we acknowledge our sins and ask for forgiveness, we can hear Jesus speaking through the priest say that our sins are forgiven. If it has been a long time since you have come to this Sacrament, don't worry! Just come on in and I or any other priest will guide you through the process. This Lent, Reconciliation will be available:

Saturday Evening before Mass at Saint Peter: 4:30 PM until 5:10 PM

Tuesday Evening before Mass at All Saints: 5:30 PM until 5:50 PM

Wednesday Evening before Mass at Saint Peter: 6:00 PM until 6:20 PM
