This weekend we are pleased to welcome Father Jonathan Fassero, OSB, who will be joining us for Saint Meinrad Sunday. Saint Meinrad plays an important role in our diocese, with most of our priests and deacons receiving formation in the Seminary, and with many others participating in programs through the School of Theology. In addition, many of us have both visited. and benefited from the prayers, of the Archabbey.
