The three principles of Lent are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. One of the best ways to pray is to use the Liturgy of the Hours. Along with the Liturgy of the Eucharist (aka, "Mass"), it is one of the two liturgies of the Church. An easy way to do this is to use the iBreviary app, or there are also several podcasts that have the Liturgy in an audio format. I would like to thank our Men's Club for organizing our parish fish fry and supporting our youth ministry programs. I am writing this on Monday, but it looks like the weather should be sunny and 70 on Friday; so I hope everyone was able to attend.

Next month we will provide our liturgical ministers with a three-month schedule. (We wanted to wait until after Easter.)
