There are also individuals who, because of their other positions in the parish, attend the meetings on an ex officio"; capacity. The council is an advisory body, so it provides advice, but it does not make decisions.

The second council in our parish is the finance council. It reviews our financial information and provides advice and consent on financial matters. However, unlike the pastoral council, on significant financial matters their consent is required to proceed. Under canon law, every parish is required to have a finance council.

So, I am very grateful for those who have volunteered to run for our pastoral council and those who are part of the various committees that help our parish.
