It is time to talk about Mass intentions again. As I said a couple of weeks ago, the law of the Church mandates that there must be a Mass intention for the People of the Parish every Sunday and Solemnity (All Saints, Annunciation, etc.) Having other Mass intentions is optional. It is possible to have one Mass intention for more than one person. However, we ask that this be kept in check to get the names in the bulletin. A Mass can have intentions from two people if both people agree. Church law also requires that any intentions that cannot be fulfilled within one year must be turned over to the diocese. The diocese will then send them to retired priests or priests outside the United States to be said. This creates a numbers crunch, we have more intentions than we can fulfill, and we don't have open space for people who die. Therefore, following the lead of other parishes, we are going to implement the following restrictions: First, no more than 10 intentions per year for a household. Second, no more than ten intentions for one person per year. (There will be exceptions for recently deceased individuals.) If you would like more Mass intentions, there are religious orders that provide this service. This is our first attempt, these rules may be adjusted as we see how things will work out.
