This Sunday is a day of great joy as we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at St. Peter. We welcome Bishop Siegel to our parish, and we give thanks to God for the young people who today receive the Holy Spirit in a new and special way.

This year students in two grades - 9th and 10th - will be Confirmed as we work towards our goal of Confirming students in the 5th grade. The diocese made this decision for several reasons, among them: First, and of most importance, our young people need the Grace that Confirmation provides much earlier as we often hear "kids are growing up faster these days". Second, in many ways it is easier to prepare younger kids for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Finally, over the decades an incorrect idea emerged that Confirmation marked "graduation" from religious education, or that it was where young people made their "adult acceptance of the Faith". Instead, at Confirmation we receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit that was first given at Baptism. Our young people need the grace of the Holy Spirit to deal with all the challenges and temptations in their lives, and that is happening much earlier than ever.
